2024/2025 Bergen County Band Audition Requirements- PERCUSSION

Percussion: Three percussion areas will be auditioned: Mallet Percussion, Timpani and Multiple Percussion. Students may choose one, two, or all three of these areas to apply for and audition. The audition requirements are:

Mallets:

- 1. Etude #4 "In Search of Maid Marian," Gary Fink, measure #7 to measure #29.
- 2. Concert Excerpt Prelude, Siciliano and Rondo Mvt. 2: Letters D to F and G to H, Mvt. 3: Meas. 1 to Letter A
- 3. Scales: D, Gb, Bb (2 oct. Major), C Chromatic, 2 oct.

Timpani:

1. Etude #4 - "Afro-Cuban Jig," Gary Fink, entire etude

Timpani tuning and rudimentary skills will be judged from the material in the etude.

Multiple Percussion:

- 1. Etude #4 "Paris 1920," Gary Fink, Beginning to meas. 31 and 53 to the end.
- 2. Concert Excerpt Prelude, Siciliano and Rondo Mvt. 3 Bass Drum (Perc. III) Letter F to the end.

Rudimentary skills will be judged from the material in the etude.

Etudes are posted on <u>www.mebci.org</u>. Students should check with their band director for Prelude, Siciliano, and Rondo parts.

The following percussion instruments will be supplied at the audition site:

Mallet Percussion: a 3 octave Musser Xylophone, a 3 octave Adams vibraphone (graduated keys), a 4 octave Musser marimba (non-graduated keys), and a 4.3 octave Adams marimba (graduated keys).

Timpani: 4 Ludwig pedal timpani, 32", 28", 26", and 23", with tuning gauges (but will be covered).

Multi Percussion: Bass Drum, Suspended Cymbal, Crash Cymbals and a carpeted table for placing small instruments. Students may supply other instruments if they choose. No instruments will be supplied for warm-up.

Students <u>must</u> supply their own sticks, beaters, tuning sources, snare drums, triangles. Students may supply other instruments if they choose. No instruments will be supplied for warm-up.
